

## **POM 2008 Emerging Economies Young Researcher Award**

The Emerging Economies Young Researcher Award (EEYRA) has been created to establish institutional linkages to reach out to future scholars in emerging economies, and to encourage their development and connection to the Production and Operations Management Society (POMS).

Any student enrolled in a Ph.D. program in an Operations Management related field in a country from one of the following three regions Africa, Australasia, and Latin America is eligible to apply. To receive the award, the student must demonstrate evidence of substantial promise as a scholar in an Operations Management related field.
